1 Scottish: relationship name from the Older Scots personal name *Dunecan*, from Irish *donn* 'brown-haired man' (which has the transferred sense 'chieftain' or 'leader' + *chad* 'warrior').

Further information

This common Scottish personal name is found in Yorks and Cumb in the 12th century. Here it was probably introduced from Ireland, as also in Somerset, where the name occurs in 1086 and as a surname in the 13th century. In 1327, in Subsidy Rolls (Somerset), there are several men named *le Ireys*, and one *Irlonde*.



given names, Scotland: Dunchad, 11th abbot of Iona, 717 in Life of Saint Columba; Duchad, abbot of Dunkeld, about 965 in Chronicles of Picts and Scots; Donchadus, earl of Fife, about 1150 in Book of Deer.

surnames, Scotland: Willelmus filius Duuecani, about 1200 in North Berwick Charters; John Dunkan, 1367 in Scotland Calendar (Berwick); Janet Duncan, 1562 in IGI (Dunfermline, Fife); Thomas Duncan, 1565 in IGI (Monifieth, Angus); Johne Duncan, 1570 in IGI (Perth, Perths); Dauid Duncan, 1573 in IGI (Aberdeen, Aberdeens); Johne Duncan, 1574 in IGI (Edinburgh, Midlothian); Catrein Dunckane, 1643 in IGI (Leith, Midlothian); Hellin Dunckan, 1667 in IGI (Kingsbarns, Fife).

2 Irish: in Ireland, adopted for **Ó Duinnchinn** 'descendant of *Donncheann*', a byname from *donn* 'brown-haired man' or 'chieftain' + *ceann* 'head'.
