<b>William Robson Swan</b>		
Monument in Kirkmahoe Parish Churchyard. Monument mentions William, John, James, and Jane Thornburn, wife of Robert.		
<b>Agnes Turnbull</b>		
1861 census: living with children in Cavers, including Margaret and Agnes Swan (Margaret born England, Agnes born in Kirkmahoe). Occupation is house servant's wife. Husband is enumerated with household where he worked.		
1871 census: Cavers East Lodge, Cavers. Living with Waugh children and granddaughter, Mary Elliot.		
1881 census: general laborer's wife. Enumerated with husband. Todlaw, Cavers.		
1891 census: Cavers. Living with husband, children, and two grandsons: Walter Swan and James Sail (?). Walter, age 7, born in Hawick, Roxburghshire; James, age 1, born in Galashiels, Selkirk)		
1901 census: Cavers, Todlaw Cottage, living with husband, grandson, Walter Swan Waugh (may be an error), and James Steele, age 11 (enumerated as SAIL in 1891 census).		
<b>Agnes Swan</b>		
At the time of her son, Walter's out of wedlock birth in Hawick, she was a seamstress.		
<b>Jane Goodfellow Waugh</b>		
1881 census: living with brothers in household of step-sister, Agnes Swan in Hawick.
