16<sup>th</sup> June 1821 Adam Hunter and Margaret Linnell were  
entered to be proclaimed for 2 Sabbaths, and  
were duly married 28<sup>th</sup> June 1821 at Killybung  
7<sup>th</sup> Decr 1821 John Fleming at Kilmorye in the Parish of  
Dumfries and Mary Tod at Kilmorye in  
this Parish were entered to be proclaimed  
for 2 Sabbaths, and were duly married  
at Kilmorye on the 30<sup>th</sup> Decr 1821—  
25<sup>th</sup> Janry 1822 John Bryden at Strickton and Sarah  
Gowie in the Parish of Kirkmahal  
were entered to be proclaimed for 2 Sabbaths  
and were duly married by James Stewart  
Minister of the Parish of Kirkmahal on the 15<sup>th</sup> Febry 1822  
29<sup>th</sup> May 1821 William Johnston and Catherine  
Menzies were duly married this day  
at Kilmorye—  
8<sup>th</sup> March 1822 James Brown at Wellington in this  
Parish and Margaret Smith in the  
Parish of Troqueer were entered to  
be proclaimed for 3 Sabbaths—  
25<sup>th</sup> May 1822 John Kirkpatrick at Wellington in  
this Parish and Elisabeth Walker  
Kirkmahal were entered to be  
proclaimed for 2 Sabbaths—  
30<sup>th</sup> May 1822 Thomas Bell in this Parish and  
Susan Buttram, Dumfries were entered  
to be proclaimed for 3 Sabbaths—  
1<sup>st</sup> June 1822 William Gowie and Henrietta Webster  
both at Carmaddie were entered to be  
proclaimed three times on Sabbath fast  
and were duly married 14<sup>th</sup> June 1822
