January 14 1728 p. p. S. K. Mary Carruthers being cited apud acta compares and ad

 officer and called did not compare he is to be cited pro secundo
 This day the session being informed that there is one Janet
 Douglas come to the place who hath not yet produced a
 testimonial they ordered one of their kumbers to call for
 the same to be presented to the session This day four o'clock
 night

January 28 A Report being made to the session that Janet
 Douglas has no testimonial and the session being otherwise
 informed by an Elder of the parish of Tweedmuir where
 she resides last that she could produce no testimonial
 to their session when demanded and the session finding that
 she has the Character of a person that goes from place to place
 and can give no account of her self they referred her
 to the civil Magistrate that he may take legal Cognisance
 with her as a bazaar person and appointed their Clerk
 to give Extracts hereof to the Bailie of the Regality
 James Johnstone being cited pro secundo and being called
 did not compare The officer is ordered to cite him pro
 secundo
