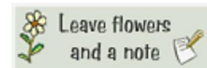

Agnes (Ann) Mitchell married John Easton Mar. 9, 1839 in Scotland. They had two children: Elizabeth, born Feb. 8, 1840 and christened Feb. 16, 1840 in Old Monkland, Lanarkshire, Scotland, and Barbara, born Dec. 2, 1841 and christened Jan. 2, 1842 in Old Monkland, Lanarkshire, Scotland.

The family joined the LDS (Mormon) Church in Scotland in 1846, and emigrated to America in 1848. John found work in the "coal diggings" at Gravois just outside of St. Louis, Missouri. Tragically, a cholera epidemic struck the area in the summer of 1849. Nearly 150 died in Gravois, and several hundred more in the wider St. Louis area. A poem written in 1849 entitled "[A Mournful Elegy on the Unfortunate Victims, Who Fell Sacrifices to the Ravages of That Fell Destroyer, the Asiatic Cholera, at the Gravois Coal Diggings, Near St. Louis, Mo., June and July, 1849](#)" by John Russel, "teacher in the doomed district", shows that "Anne Easton, 30, wife of John, and two children" [Elizabeth and Barbara] were among the victims at Gravois.
