Relationship Notes for Edward "Ned" Pennykid and Elexis Waugh

Married by declaration and sheriff's warrant (irregular marriage).

Edward "Ned" Pennykid

Occupation: Candlemaker when Elexis filed a paternity suit in 1895. Later his occupation was oil works foreman

At time of death, lived in Pumpherston, West Lothian

1901 census: Uphall. Living with wife and three children. (unable to locate Elizabeth). Occupation: laborer in oil works.

1911 census: Uphall. Stillman in oil works. Elexis indicated she had given birth to nine children and that seven were living.

Elexis Waugh

First child was illegitimate. Elexis was housekeeper per birth certificate. Elexis sued Ed Pennykid for paternity for the birth of the first child.

Notes: (con't)

Elexis was one of the aunts Jock Waugh regularly visited in Scotland when he had leave during WWII. They said that without Jock's food ration coupons they didn't know how they would have made it through the war. Jock was stationed in Bournemouth, England with the RCAF.

John Pennykid

Informant on father's death certificate. Gave address of Pumpherston Rd, Uphall
1959: informant on mother's death certificate. Listed address as 18 Latham Gardens, Pumpherston.
Marriage: scotlandspeople, only John Pennykid. Unable to view reocrd due to privacy policies.
