#### John Carpenter

1910 census: Belle, Wood Co, OK Occupation: self-employed cement contractor.

1920 census: Chicago, IL Occupation: machinist.

1920 census: factory machinist.

#### Margaret Cochrane Waugh

At time of birth, father was a railway goods clerk and mother was a domestic servant. Parents were not married. Born at 20 Academy St, Bathgate.

1901 census: living with parents and siblings in Bathgate. Occupation: dressmaker (app)

Moved to Chicago with family in 1905. Margaret moved to Kansas in 1935. She only had one child. (source: findagrave.com)

Buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Newton, KS.

Informant on son's death certificate in 1956. At the time she listed her residence as Highland, CA. (source: findagrave.com)

July 10, 1906: immigrated (apparently alone) on ship *Numidian* from Glasgow via Montreal.

Occupation: dressmaker. Destination: Chicago.

1910 census: Belle, Woods Co, OK. Living with husband, John, and son. Margaret immigrated in 1906.

1920 census: Chicago, IL. Immigrated 1906, naturalized citizen.

1930 census: Chicago.

1940 census: living with son in Chicago. Completed 4 years of high school. (son completed 5 years of college - occupation: auditor) Address: 4878 Magnolia St, Chicago. Same address in 1935.

### Notes

Earl Bruce Carpenter was the son of John S Carpenter, 25 years old, of Nebraska and Margaret Carpenter, 23 years old, of Scotland.

Information taken from the United States Census, 1910 of Woods County, Oklahoma.

The 1930 Census, United States of Chicago Districts 1001-1250, Cook County, Illinois reads:

John Carpenter, 45, Nebraska

Margaret Carpenter, 43, Scotland

Case B. (presumed Earl B.) Carpenter, 20, Oklahoma.

The 1940 Census of Chicago shows Margaret, 52, widowed and Earl, 30, Oklahoma, living with her with occupation of being an auditor for the State of Illinois.

The death certificate states that Earl Bruce Carpenter was the son of John Carpenter, Nebraska, and Margaret Waugh Carpenter, Scotland, born in Oklahoma on December 10, 1909. E. B., 46, was an accountant who never married. The last 4 years of his life he lived in Tucson. He died at home due to a coronary occlusion and atherosclerosis on October 7, 1956. E. B. was buried on October 11, 1956.

The signer of the death certificate is Mrs. Margaret Carpenter Andres of Highland, California, his mother.
