

At Dumfries the 4th day of March 1857
 J. S. J. of the C. of Dumfries in and
 before the Sheriff Court of said
 County, at the instance of James
 Tait residing at Brydekirk village
 in the parish of Annan, Pursuer against
 John Bell Milnwright, at Chapelton
 in the parish of Half Merton Defender.
 The Sheriff in absence, Decreed and
 Ordained and hereby Decrees and
 Ordains the said John Bell Milnwright
 to make payment to the said James
 Tait pursuer of the sum of £1-11-6
 being the amount of milnyng expenses
 attending the birth of an illegitimate
 female child born by the pursuer on the
 1st day of May 1853 and of which child the said
 Defender is the father. Item of the sum
 of 4 pounds 8s being the amount due for
 the first years alimony of said child
 and payable quarterly and in advance
 but under deduction of 15 shillings 6d
 to acct. Item of the like sum of 21 pounds
 8s yearly for the future alimony and
 upbringing of said child, until the
 said child shall reach the age of 10 years
 complete payable quarterly in advance
 as aforesaid all in manner abovesaid
 Memo of Interest upon the said sum
 from the said date respectively until
 become and are yet to fall due to be
 paid. Item of the sum of 3 shillings
 farther as the expense of extracting

At Dumfries the 3rd day of Sept 1857 and
 30th day of January and 3 and 13th days of Feby
 1857 years sitting in Judgment S. J. S. E. J.
 J. S. J. of the County of Dumfries, in and
 before the Sheriff Court of said County
 at the instance of Elizabeth Clark re Men-
 ouchie spouse of William Menouchie Junior
 residing at Lochmaben and the said
 William Menouchie for himself and for his
 interest Pursuers against Charles Haugh
 Senior Junior residing at Lochside Lochmaben
 Defender which action was advocated by the
 said defendo to the Court of Session, but the
 reasons for which advocators were in said
 Court refused, and the said action remitted
 simpliciter to the Sheriff. The Sheriff Decreed
 and Ordained and hereby Decrees and Ordains
 the said Charles Haugh Senior Defendo to
 make payment to the said Pursuers of the
 sum of £1-11-6 8d of milnyng expenses attend-
 ing the birth of an illegitimate female child
 of which the female pursuer was delivered
 in or about the 11 day of Nov 1817 and of which
 the said defendo is the father. Item of interest
 upon the said sum at the rate of 2% per cent from the said date
 of birth until payment. Item of the sum
 of £4 8s yearly in name of alimony main-
 tenance clothing and education of said child
 payable half yearly and in advance commens-
 ing the 1st half yearly payment as on
 the said date of birth, and so on half yearly
