## McCormack

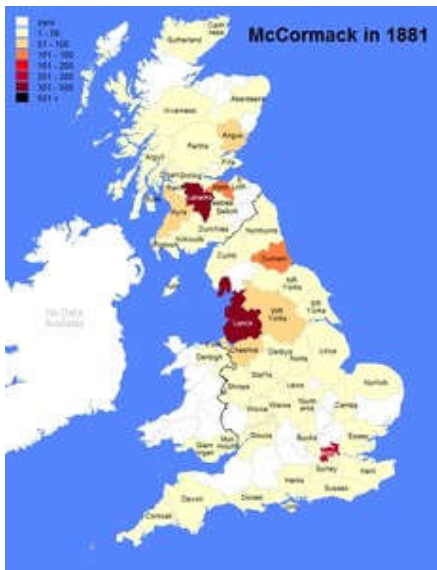
**Variants:** McCORMICK, CORMACK, McCORMAC

- **Current frequencies:** GB 9412, Ireland 7594
- **GB frequency 1881:** 2143
- **Main GB location 1881:** Lancs; Glasgow; London
- **Main Irish location 1847–64:** widespread: esp. Antrim, Donegal, Tyrone

Irish, Scottish Gaelic: from **Mac Cormaic** 'son of *Cormac*', a personal name based on *corb* 'raven' + *mac* 'son'.

### Early bearers:

Aengus Mac Cormaic, abbot, 1212 in AU (Bangor, Down); Mael-Sechlainn Mac Carmaic, brughaidh, 1330 in AU; Fergal Mac Cormaic, 1347 in AU; Gillapatraig and Donnchadh Mag Carmuic, 1431 in AU (Fermanagh); Ruaidhri glas Mag Carmuic, poet, 1475 in AU; Dermot McCormoke oge, preceptor, 1545 in Fiants Elizabeth §461 (Morne alias Manynymon, Cork); William McCarmyke, chaplain, 1546 in Fiants Elizabeth §502.
